1. **Haiti: Petit Trou Project of Cistern construction for the local school-Marsha Walsh and Gretchen Berggren, Champions.**

2. **Guatemala: Clean Water Project-Mike and Ann Moore, Champions**

3. **Peru-Clean Water Project at Hogar de Crist in Cusco, Peru- Rocco Dodson, Champion**

4. **Water Project in Angola and Liberia: Dean Haave and Roseanne Stiblo, Champions**

The Evergreen Rotary Foundation has sent the check for this project and this project is closed.

5. **Water Project in El Salvador: Dave Rommelman, Champion**

Dave Rommelman left for El Salvador on March 9 and returned on March 17th. The Living Water Group that he was with was fortunate enough to construct two wells with pumps that will provide safe drinking water for a school of around 500 kids and 25 families. Dave will be preparing a presentation including a step by step explanation of the process of getting involved in such a water project and a detailed cost analysis. He will try to convey the significance of safe drinking water for the recipients of such a project. The presentation will be given to four to six Rotary Clubs in our area. He hopes to raise enough funds to drill three to four wells next year. He will also be applying for District and International matching grants to assist with the costs of these projects.

We have received a request for help for a water project in Nepal. This project is still seeking a champion.

We were asked to submit an application for the George K. Davis Humanitarian Award for our club's participation in Water Projects. We chose to submit the application for the water projects in Chiapas, Mexico in partnership with Healing Waters.

Barbara Wingate, Clean Water Projects Committee Chair did submit the application and we are waiting to hear from the Awards Committee. The Award Criteria document is attached for reference.
