**Description of project:**

St. Anthony Hospitals is part of the Catholic Health Initiatives (CHI) health care system. CHI is the second largest Catholic Health Care system in the US and is deeply committed to the care of the poor and underserved not only in America, but also around the globe. Born out of this commitment was the development of the Bach Mai Hospital Project. The Bach Mai Hospital is located in Hanoi, Vietnam.

Due to the extraordinary high cost of medical equipment, and low salaries in Vietnam, (physicians earn on average \$7000 US per year) most of the physicians and nurses at the Bach Mai Hospital cannot afford such basic items as stethoscopes. Below is a list of equipment needs requested by the physicians and nurses at the Bach Mai Hospital.

Physician Stethoscopes	35 @ \$ 83.00	=	\$2,905
Nursing Stethoscopes	50 @ \$ 36.00	=	\$1,800
Personal Digital Assistants	35 @ \$200.00	=	\$7,000
Blood Pressure cuffs	50 @ \$ 60.00	=	\$3,000
Digital thermometers	50 @ \$ 37.00	=	\$1,850
ACLS Training Dummy	1 @ \$2,948	=	\$2,948
<b>Total Cost of equipment</b>			<b><u>\$19,503</u></b>
