2. Togo: Clean Water Project-Mike and Ann Moore, Champions

2.1. Mike and Ann Moore and Barbara Wingate met with Zenia Tada of IDE (International Development Enterprise) last week. Zenia is the Executive Director and Director of Development. They have been approached by several clubs in our district, but has stressed that if Rotary wants to partner with IDE, we must be where they are. Their current focus in on India and China.

2.2. Zenia presented to us two systems that IDE is working with. One of these systems may be a possibility for a partnering project with Rotary. Mike feels it would be best to promote any partnership at the national level.

3. Peru-Clean Water Project at Hogar de Crist in Cusco, Peru- Rocco Dodson, Champion

3.1. Rocco is seeking support for two new projects in Peru.

3.1.1. The orphanage that he and his family now support in Anta, near Cusco has 20 residents and through their lunch program feed 80 additional kids who walk 1-2 hours from the surrounding hills.

3.1.2. Because of increased support for this orphanage, they are now taking steps to support another orphanage near Cusco, in the Village of Lamay. This orphanage has about 80 kids and has a lunch program for another 220 kids who walk in to school.

3.2. Both of these projects need a source of clean drinking water. Local Rotary clubs in the area in and around Cusco have indicated a willingness to partner on these projects. Together we could provide water for around 400 children.
