1. Group Study Exchange

- 1.1. The exchanges for next year will be from Germany (April 9- May 8, 2008) and South Africa (April 1- May 5).
- 1.2. I have agreed to be a district co-coordinator for the South African team along with Sandy Algermissen of the Golden Club.
 - 1.2.1. Evergreen will share the hosting of the South Africa team April 5-9.
 - 1.2.2. Rotary Club of Evergreen has three hosts, Roseann Stiblo and Dean Haave, Pat Martin and Bob Stillmock, and Barbara and John Wingate. They will give a program at the Golden club on Tuesday morning. We will not host the team for our Friday program.
 - 1.2.3. We are planning a Joint Rotary Club Social, (Evergreen, Golden, Conifer, and Mt Foothills) when we receive the Team from Boulder Rotary on Saturday afternoon from 2:00 to 4:00 pm at Mt Vernon CC. RCoE will be coordinating the vocations days on Monday April 7 and Wednesday April 9.

2.1. Outbound:

- 2.1.1. To my knowledge, we have no Evergreen outbound students for next year.

2.2. Inbound

- 2.2.1. Our club's inbound student this year is Flora Victoria Kiss-Dozsai from Szentendre, Hungary. She arrived on August 14th and is attending Evergreen high school.
