Dolly Parton's Imagination Library is a book gifting program that mails free, high-quality books to children from birth until age 5, no matter their family's income.

Since the initial program launch in the United States, Dolly Parton's Imagination Library has gone from just a few dozen books to over 60,000,000 books mailed to children in the United States, Canada and across the pond to the UK. Currently, over 1,600 local communities provide the Imagination Library to over 750,000 children each and every month.

The local Mountain Area Imagination Library program is sponsored and funded by the joint effort of five mountain area Rotary clubs (Rotary Clubs of Evergreen, Conifer, Mountain Foothills, Peak to Peak and Clear Creek 2000). Children enrolled in this early literacy program reside in various local mountain foothills communities in certain areas of Jefferson, Clear Creek, Park and Gilpin Counties.
